

NJNG to Replace Aged Infrastructure in Ortley Beach in April

As a part of its Safety Acceleration and Facility Enhancement (SAFE) program approved by the New Jersey Board of Public Utilities in 2012, New Jersey Natural Gas (NJNG) is replacing certain portions of its existing infrastructure that is aged and most susceptible to corrosion and leaks.

Beginning in early April, NJNG will be replacing 5,125 feet of 2-inch, bare steel distribution main and associated services in Ortley Beach, NJ. The following roads will be affected:

- **Durborow Avenue, 1st Avenue and Haag Avenue** from Bay Boulevard west to Route 35, Southbound
- **Washington Avenue** from 2nd Avenue to Haag Avenue
- **Baltimore Avenue** from 2nd Avenue to Trenton Avenue
- **Fort Avenue** from Route 35, Northbound to East Central Avenue
- **7th Street** from Route 35, Northbound to Pennsylvania Avenue East
- **Sea Gull Lane** from Route 35, Northbound to Railway Avenue East
- **Railway Avenue East** from Sea Gull Lane to 1st Avenue

Main installation is expected to last approximately six weeks. During construction, please be mindful of potential traffic impacts, including lane shifts, closures and detours.

NJNG's contractor will replace and/or reconnect all natural gas service lines in the project area at no cost to the property owner. Affected property owners will be contacted to make arrangements for their natural gas service to be restored at a mutually agreeable time. Additionally, in order to relight all appliances NJNG will require access to the property.
