***WHEREAS, The Very Reverend Robert S. Grodnicki (“Father Bob Grodnicki”)** came to the parish of St. Luke Toms River 17 years ago in 2006 where he served 3 years as Parochial Vicar until August of 2009 when Bishop Smith named **Fr. ***WHEREAS, before entering the Seminary in 1982, Fr. Bob** was employed as an accountant with the State of New Jersey and received his Master of Divinity (M.Div.) degree in 1987 from Washington Theological Union, after which he was ordained as a Transitional Deacon in 1987; **Fr. Bob** was ordained in the Priesthood (Augustinian) in April of 1988; and*

***WHEREAS, Fr. Bob** earned a Master of Social Work (M.S.W) in 1991 from Loyola University Chicago and earned a Licensed Clinical Social Worker (L.C.S.W.) in 1998 from the State of Illinois. He worked for the New York Foundling; Illinois Department of Children & Family Services (D.C.F.S. Illinois); and Catholic Charities-Chicago; joining the Diocese of Trenton in 2006; and*

***WHEREAS, Fr. Bob** has served the parishioners of St. Luke Toms River tirelessly, faithfully and with great compassion, opening the parish doors to the community with 10 Alcoholics Anonymous (A.A.) Groups (19 meetings); 6 Al Anon Groups; 3 Gamblers Anonymous (G.A.) Groups; Compassionate Friends Aphasia Group; training for police dogs CONTACT; St. Vincent de Paul Society; and seminars on drug addiction and palliative care.*

**RESOLUTION OF THE TOWNSHIP COUNCIL, TOWNSHIP OF TOMS RIVER, OCEAN COUNTY, NEW JERSEY, RETROACTIVELY AUTHORIZING A LICENSE AGREEMENT WITH CELLCO PARTNERSHIP (D/B/A/ VERIZON WIRELESS) FOR THE TEMPORARY USE OF TOWNSHIP PROPERTY LOCATED AT 1931 RAILWAY AVE. TO LOCATE A TEMPORARY CELL TOWER TO ENSURE SUFFICIENT CELLULAR COVERAGE ON THE BARRIER ISLAND DURING PEAK SUMMER MONTHS**

**June 14, 2023**

**WHEREAS**, Cellco Partnership (d/b/a Verizon Wireless) (“Cellco”) informed the Township that its wireless infrastructure may not have sufficient capacity to handle all of the cell phone and data usage during the population boom on the barrier island during the peak summer months; and

**WHEREAS**, the lack of sufficient wireless capacity presents an emergent public safety issue, as 80% of 911 calls are cell phone generated and because a strain on the wireless infrastructure could compromise other public safety communications systems, including police radios, and make it difficult for people to contact friends and family members in emergent situations; and

**WHEREAS**, to avert this public safety hazard, Cellco requested the temporary use of Township property located at 1931 Railway Ave. in the Ortley Beach section of the Township to locate a temporary cell tower from May through September to ensure sufficient capacity; and

**WHEREAS**, the Township and Cellco have negotiated a license agreement to that effect, attached hereto as Schedule A:

**NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED** by the Township Council, Township of Toms River, Ocean County, New Jersey, as follows:

1. The license agreement between the Township and Cellco, attached hereto as Schedule A, allowing for the placement of a temporary cell tower at 1931 Railway Ave. is hereby approved on the terms and conditions stated therein.
2. The license agreement expires on September 30, 2023, upon which date the cell tower must be removed.

Administrator Lou Amoruso stated that it was done just as an emergency for the summer and will be done September 2023.

Councilman Rodrick asked why it's not on the water tower like it was last year.

Councilman Lamb stated that it was done on a condo unit not water tower last year, but agrees that he doesn't understand why the location wasn't discussed with the public and council beforehand.

Administrator Lou Amoruso explained that they did not pick a location they were told by Verizon where it would be placed, that it was critical for everyone's safety.

## **ELECTED OFFICIALS' COMMENTS**

Council Member Lamb thanked the dedicated EMS members for the CSO program. He stated that there needs to be 24/7 EMS coverage on the Barrier Island. Councilman Lamb congratulated Councilman Rodrick on the Primary Election victory. He hopes that they can all work together to fix the issues in Toms River. Councilman Lamb thanked all the voters for coming out to vote, and thanked Mayor Hill for all his service with the community for over 20 years.

Council Member Quinlisk thanked Mayor Hill for all his contributions to Toms River Township.

Council Member Rodrick started by thanking all the voters for their support in the Primary Elections. He congratulated his team on the primary victory and thanked his family for all their help.

Council Vice-President Geoghegan & Council Member Kopp had no comment.

Council Member Ciccozzi spoke about how Downtown Night Out is doing amazing and thanked the BID for all the events Downtown. He hopes that they continue to have events for the community. Councilman Ciccozzi stated that the Planning Board has zero applications. He asked that the council no longer call into meetings if they cannot make the meeting.

Mayor Hill thanked the voters for the turnout for the primary election and congratulated Councilman Rodrick on his win. He stated that Freddy's Frozen Custard & Steakhburgers had their grand opening today and everyone should give it a try.

Council President Lotano thanked all the voters for coming out and congratulations to all the victors. He spoke about Freddy's opening and how they are excited to be a part of the BID and to work some of the festivals downtown. Mayor's Advisory Committee is having a fundraiser at Jersey Mike's on June 15. The Downtown Line Dancing event was a success. The Council would like to invest in solar power garbage cans for downtown to cut down on pollution. Council President Lotano closed by congratulating all the graduates of 2023.



## **PUBLIC COMMENTS**

Council President Lotano announced the public portion and asked if anyone wished to speak at this time.

Geri Ambrosio, 938 Millstone Court, spoke on issues with EMS on Barrier Island; needs 24/7 coverage. Geri would like to cut wasteful fees in town such as the newsletter. She congratulated Councilman Rodrick on his win in the primary election and said now all the Republicans should work together to help the town.

Frank Davis, 20 West Ridge, spoke about it being a state issue with ambulance coverage and not having enough volunteers. He reminded everyone that 2 Councilmen voted no on a bond ordinance for ambulance, and the same 2 voted no for the cell tower for emergency service.

Sharon Collucci from the Environmental Commission handed out a packet on pollinator gardens in Ortley beach.

Paul Williams, 35 Broad St., spoke on the primary election. The Democratic slate was not vetted or interviewed. He stated John Furey does not live in Toms River Township.

Dana Tormollan, Messenger St, spoke on the primary election and how the town is divided. She doesn't feel Lynne O'Toole will be a good council member, because she never goes to any of the Zoning Board meetings, and she is on the board. Thanked Freddy's for contributing food for Pop the Trunk food drive.

Kathy Lazaro, Toms River, asked that Council Member Ciccozzi resign. Kathy congratulated Rodrick on his primary victory. She said the barrier island needs 24/7 EMS coverage, whether it be volunteer or paid. She would like the town to stop enforcing Municipal Certificate of Continued Use and Occupancy for resale of homes.

Art Anderson, 12 Park St., asked if the town had any information about the parkway project, and if they were putting walls up by the Toms River exits. Township Engineer, Robert Chankalian stated that he has not received any information yet and will look into it.

Debbie Martin, 1921 Ocean Ave, stated that 7,000 beach badges sold already this year and she doesn't understand where they will go. She said the beaches have improved but there still is a lot of work that needs to be done.

Anthony Colucci, Ortley Beach Voters and Taxpayers Association stated that the ramps and rails on the beaches in Ortley need to be fixed.

Mairin Bellack, Director of Toms River BID, said how proud she is of her staff, and invited the council to come to a BID meeting to meet everyone and see what they do.

Robert Burns, congratulated Rodrick on his primary win. He hopes the new mayor will help preserve the town instead of trying to build it up. Robert Burns says he may have some resolutions for the town issues if the Council would like to meet with him.

On motion by Council Vice-President Geoghegan, seconded by Council Member Kopp and carried, the public hearing was **closed**.

No other business appearing, the meeting was **adjourned** at 7:03 P. M., on motion with Council Vice-President Geoghegan seconded by Council Member Kopp, and carried with Council Members Ciccozzi, Kopp, Lamb, Quinlisk, Rodrick, Council Vice-President Geoghegan, and Council President Lotano voting yes.
